






## TSR Asks: What teaching experience do future students want?

We asked prospective 2022 entry undergraduates how they would like to access teaching when they start university

**Just 46% wanted all lectures to be face-to-face on campus, whereas more than half (51%) preferred a hybrid approach combining online and face-to-face learning. The majority expected to be able to view face-to-face lectures and tutorials online on demand afterwards.**

**Base:** 406 responses (2022 entry)
